

Materials Needed To Complete Earrings: 1 pc Metallic Gold 14 count perforated paper, #24 tapestry needle, short beading needle, DMC floss, Mill Hill beads, 4 gold jump rings, 2 gold fishhook earwires, needle nose pliers, & embroidery scissors.

Cross Stitch & Bead: Use 3 strands of floss to cross stitch 2 motifs. Use 2 strands of DMC #602 floss to bead them. (Put 1 strand of floss through the eye of the beading needle and pull the end down so there are 2 working strands.) Backstitch both motifs using 2 strands of DMC #602 Maraschino Cherry.

Finishing Instructions: To make 1 earring, cut out a stitched motif, leaving a border of 1 square beyond the stitches all the way around. To back the motif, glue a piece of metallic gold perforated paper that is slightly larger than the stitched motif to the back, wrong sides together. Let dry. Using embroidery scissors, trim the backing to the edge of the motif's border. Using needle nose pliers, attach 2 jump rings and fishhook earwire at the top of the motif. Repeat all finishing instructions one more time to complete a pair of earrings.

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
